# Monthly Payment Plan

Parents who wish to pay monthly should write a formal letter, requesting to pay in monthly installments. The last payment of the monthly installments is October 2024.

#### Exercise and text books

The school wishes to thank all parents for buying the necessary stationery and for covering the exercise and text books, which have been issued by the different subject teachers. Each textbook is numbered, and each learner will be given a set of different textbooks of all subjects, but with one number has their own specific number. The school expects learners to cover all text and reading books and take good care of it as the life span of each text book is supposedly five years. Unfortunately, damaged and lost text and reading books will have to be paid for at E250-00 The school spends a lot of money buying text and readers and we plead with parents to help our learners to take good care of their text and reading books.

# Staffing

Khanyisile has retained all its staff members. However, A new staff member in Grade Zero has joined the school and we wish to welcome her and hope she will add value to our Pre School and be committed to the learners' education. Teacher Sitembile is now the other Grade One Teacher.



Parents are encouraged to work hand in glove with the school, to get to know their child/ren's teachers and what they expect from each learner in the various subjects.

## Extra-curricular activities

Sporting activities have resumed for all grades, as we already have the Rounders and Girls' Soccer Festivals on our hands. Grade Ones and Twos sports time is 1 pm -2.10 pm. Grade Threes to Sevens sports time is 2 pm -3pm. Sports will only be done two days be per week, which is Tuesdays and Thursdays. Learners are expected to carry their training shoes and soccer boots. All classes will go to the swimming pool, if the weather is conducive for swimming. We therefore plead with learners who still don't have a swimming costume/trunk to purchase one from the office, as all sizes are now available. A sports string bag to carry their swimming items is available in the office at E60-00. All learners must consult their time table to find out which days they are swimming.

## School uniform

Navy blue and white golf T-shirts, together with shorts and skorts, as well as the khaki pants are sold at the school office. However, the dress is sold at Unozidumo Shop in Manzini. School bags and reading bags are also available for sale at the school office. Navy blue sports hat.

All uniform that is currently out of stock is on order and it will be available soon. The girls should wear their dresses with the short navy or black tights underneath and a navy-blue jersey on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.



Tuesdays and Thursday's girls wear their white golfer and skorts. Black school shoes and white socks daily.

Boys should wear their navy-blue Golfers and khaki long pants on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.

As I conclude, I would like to encourage parents to work with the school at all times for our learners to progress and to develop well in their respective grades.

Please make time to read all the messages that the school or teachers communicate with you in the respective grades.

Also kindly communicate directly with the teachers pertaining to school matters or feel free to communicate with the office, if you can't get hold of the teacher. Please try not to call teachers directly during learning time, as teachers are not allowed to answer calls during learning time. The office will take a message to the teacher on your behalf. Kindly try to allow our learners to be punctual for school each day. Speak to drivers who drop off our learners late because they take learners from many schools. Our advice is to put your child on transport that only comes to Khanyisile School.
